- Never use bad or abusive language or make derogatory remarks. Threatening or rude gestures will also not be tolerated by PUMA and Willetton Basketball Association.
- Have good control and attitude – be focussed

Respect Your Opponent

- Treat your opponent the way you would like to be treated
- Thank the opposition, the scorers and your supporters at the end of the game.

Respect Officials

- Accept and respect the official's decision
- Thank the officials – referees and scorers at the end of the game
- If you have an issue, raise it in a respectful way with your Coach after the game

- Listen and learn from your Coach and Manager. Thank them for their time and efforts.
